The use of public transport in Kuala Lumpur has declined from 35% in 1980 to about 16% in recent years. In stepping up efforts for public transport improvement, the government has set a goal to increase public transport usage to 25% by Year 2012, as well as to target a ratio of 70:30 for private to public vehicle ownership.

Integration – in regard to regulation, planning, network route and infrastructure – is seen as the chief missing link in our transport network and will be the key towards a more efficient public transport network. Stemming from this and major issues & concerns raised at ASLI's inaugural summit in 2008, the National Summit on Urban Public Transport 2009 shall resume its objective in providing a platform in bringing together key industry players to brainstorm on possible collaborative efforts and generate new ideas on improving urban public transport.
